	cycles. We are continuing to observe the tadpoles in our classroom.
Mathematical	The children will be able to make their own caterpillars in the playdough and we will count the number of
Development (MD)	bodies we can roll out and consider how many eyes they have or how many legs etc. We will also be looking at
