## **Entry Guidelines**

Chapel Gallery's Arts Development Team, in partnership with Edge Hill University, are working together to promote The Big Read, a national initiative that encourages reading for pleasure.

To coincide with the **Association of Illustrator's World Illustration Awards** exhibition at Chapel Gallery; running from 9 *March to 27 April,* we are inviting people to redesign the book cover of a favourite book and enter it into this competition.

## **Submission Process**

- Entries can be any media including: paint, photography, print, collage or digital.
- Entries should be emailed as a high resolution/good print quality jpg image to <a href="mailto:studentexperience@edgehill.ac.uk">studentexperience@edgehill.ac.uk</a> This includes digital images or paintings, collages etc that must be scanned in and digitised before sending.
- When sending your email with image attached, please include:
  - o Your name
  - o A contact telephone number
  - o The title and author of the book that's inspired your work
  - o What Key Stage you are (i.e. KS1, KS2, KS3 or KS4) or 16 +.
  - Whether or not you are a Student and, if you are a Student, which school, college or university you attend.
- If your entry is shortlisted for exhibition at the Chapel Gallery you will be notified by email
- The deadline for receipt of entries is 9am on Friday 29 March 2019.
- Successful shortlisted entries will be exhibited at the Chapel Gallery from Wednesday 3 April until Saturday 29 June 2019.

- All shortlisted entries will be exhibited at the Chapel Gallery.
- Three works selected by our Guest Judges will receive copies of Eleanor Oliphant is Completely Fine, signed by the author, Gail Honeyman.
- One entry will be announced as overall winner and will receive a signed copy of Eleanor Oliphant is Completely Fine, as above, and will also be awarded an £100 prize.
- The entry that receives the most votes from visitors to the exhibition and will receive a signed copy of Eleanor Oliphant is completely fine, as above, and will also be awarded an £50 prize.
