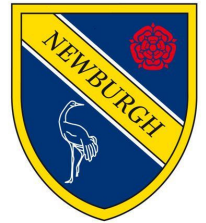

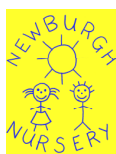
Newburgh Nursery & All Round Care News
