Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSE)	<p>Last week we spent the morning in Gospel Value family groups. Each half term, the whole school split into mixed age groups for a morning or afternoon to focus on the term's Gospel Value. Team Crane are put into the same family group as their Buddy and any family members. Each group is named after a tree and I will add the name of your child's family group to their diary ASAP.</p> <p>This term's Gospel Value is Respect. We will also continue to establish our Golden Values.</p>
Physical Development (PD)	<p>We will talk about how we stay healthy including a healthy diet and will make 'Super Soup'.</p>
Communication & Language (CL)	<p>We will share our Number Detective home challenge as we develop both our skills of number and of communicating. We will also talk about our understanding of 'Respect'.</p>
Literacy (LD)	<p>This week's focus letters are m,d,g,o, and the high frequency 'and'. We will blend sounds together in order to read words.</p> <p>Please make sure children have their reading books in reading packets at all times to enable us to read with them and change their books throughout the week. A brief comment written in their reading record is valued.</p>
Mathematical Development (MD)	<p>Our maths sessions will focus on counting, matching numerals to quantity and ordering numbers. Much of our learning starts by watching an episode of Numberblocks and then talking about, and working with, some of the principles shared during each episode.</p>
Understanding the World (UW)	<p>We will learn something about how vegetables grow by going out to our vegetable patch and digging up some fresh vegetables to use in our Super Soup. Don't forget to bring in some autumn treasures such as conkers, acorns, pinecone, leaves etc. to add to our collection.</p>
Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)	<p>We will look at a variety artwork which uses vegetables as a resource and, before we make our soup, we will use vegetables as materials to make vegetable faces.</p>
Other Information	<p>Thank you to those of you who attended our phonics workshop, I hope you found it helpful.
