## Our theme is All About Me

Personal, Social,	Children will be taking on roles within our continuous provision. We have turned our
Emotional Development (PSE)	role play area into an aeroplane. Children will have the opportunity to take on small responsibilities such as being helping hands and pouring their own drink at snack time.
Physical Development (PD)	Skillwise sports is every Friday morning so children can come into nursery with trainers and tracksuit pants. Children will be doing lots of hall activities – sometimes I'm like a tree my ARMS stick out like BRANCHES and sometimes I'M like a snail and go – VERY SLOW. Sometimes we STOMP, CHOMP and ROAR like a DINOSAURS.
Communication & Language (CL)	Children will be continuing to share their summer diaries, talking about their holidays and talking about our families. For example, who's in our family?
Literacy (LD)	The story of the week is SHINE / What Makes Me a Me? We will be learning about being different and having unique qualities.
Mathematical	Children will have opportunities to go on number hunts around the indoor and
Development (MD)	outdoor environments. We will be looking for numbers 1-10. Children can keep their eyes peeled for numbers outside of nursery e.g. car registrations, house numbers etc.
Understanding the	Children will be learning and talking about special events/learning about different
World (UW)	cultures/the different people we see on our holidays e.g. what did they look like?
Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)	Children will be continuing to collage paper plate faces, talking about different textures – fluffy, curly or straight hair, skin colour etc. Children will use a wide range of materials to create their faces. Children will be shining their light making mirrors, stars and exploring the glitter shining in our playdough and water.
Nursery Challenge	Being more independent putting our shoes and coats on. A polite request please allow children's shoes to be easily fastened e.g. straps rather than buckles also reminding our little ones to ask a teacher when needing the toilet. Thank you!
