Our theme is Christmas Story

Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSE)	We are changing the role play into a nativity, children can take on the role of the three wise men, Mary, Joseph and baby Jesus to retell the story to act out with our friends taking on different roles.
Physical Development (PD)	Children will be writing their own words for the role play area such as star, angels, baby Jesus, Mary Joseph and wise men.
Communication & Language (CL)	Children will be retelling the Christmas story using the sequence cards, being able to talk about each card.
Literacy (LD)	Our story of the week will be 'The Christmas story' learning the Christmas words and initial sounds.
Mathematical Development (MD)	Focusing on numbers 1-3 and beyond 3, three wise men, I'm 3 years old and Matching quantity to number
Understanding the World (UW)	Children to understand why we wear red poppies for Remembrance Day. Over the next two weeks children will be learning the Christmas story and why we celebrate the birth of Jesus.
Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)	Children will doing lots of creative activities around the Nativity such as making a star, three wise men, making parcels – frankincense, Gold and Myrrh.
Nursery Challenge	Help your child to use their toys to make up a story – using materials as capes, cardboard boxes as castles and spaceships when they are pretending to be somebody else or going on an adventure.
