Dear Parents and Carers,

Orders for tickets must be in by Monday as extra tickets will be released after this day. This will also be our annual Christmas Jumper day (children to wear their best, or worst Christmas jumper to school).

**Monday 16th December**— We will be having a snow theme day in school. Children will participate in a range of snow themed activities in the morning. We will have a special party lunch menu for dinner and in the afternoon we will be taking children to a private viewing of "The Snowman" and "The Snowman and the Snowdog" at Parbold Picture House. 
Hopefully there will be at least one event in our packed calendar that family members will be able to attend.
