Dear Parents and Carers,

There are not enough words to describe how proud I was to introduce our children and choir at the performance in church yesterday. They performed beautifully and were a credit to our community. Thanks must be passed on to James for creating such a wonderful atmosphere and production.

Our younger children are all now practising hard for the Nativity on Friday. Access to the school field will be from 1.30pm with the performance due to start around 2pm and last for around 45 minutes. Refreshments will be available in the school hall after the performance. After Christmas please consider sending your Christmas cards into school for children to make use of. We will also make good use of old Christmas trees and we are in need of pallets for our Forest school.

Thursday 19th December—Break up at 1pm.


