Lesson 1- Find equivalent fractions

Use the number lines and fill in the missing fractions. Use these to help you to find equivalent fractions.

Lesson 2- Shading fractions of shapes

Colour in the fractions of the shapes and use them to help you to work out equivalent fractions.

Lesson 3- Comparing fractions

Compare the fractions using the < (less than), > (greater than) and = (equal to) symbols.

Lesson 4- Ordering fractions

Use your developing knowledge and understanding of fractions and number lines to help you to order them.

Lesson 5- Adding fractions

Use your knowledge of addition to add fractions that have the same denominator.
