1. Multiplication.

Remember X means 'equal groups of'.

2. Using arrays.

Arrays are pictures showing equal groups, you can use repeated addition to help you.

2 times table.

You know how to count in steps of 2, you can do this!

4. 5 times table.

You know how to count in steps of 5, you've got this! You can use your fingers and toes to help.

5. Try your skills at the Challenge!

#### **Creative Curriculum Focus**

Watch the Castle power point and then read the Features of a Castle quick comprehension, how many facts can you remember? You should now know all the features of castles!

Take a walk and locate any high points (Parbold Hill, Beacon), towers, chimneys and other tall structures. Can you make a simple sketch map of what you can see and where? Can you use a simple key to identify the features?
