Literacy Core Learning

Activities for the week ahead:

Our Literacy this week is all about Shoes! We will be watching video clips and reading all about different shoes! The activities are:

- Watching different versions of 'The Elves and the Shoemaker'.
- Making lists of types of shoes!
- Using a range of vocabulary to describe 'The Shoe People'.
- Creating your own new Shoe Person character!
- Comparing advertisements for shoes.

Phonics/G.P.S. Focus

Our spellings this week are from word families based on common words. They show how words are related in form and meaning. The PowerPoint for these spellings have been sent to you on Purplemash. Have fun!

A PowerPoint about past simple and present simple tenses has also been sent to you if you would like to have a look. You could write your own sentences using different tenses!

Mathematics Core Learning

We are learning about fractions once again this week. Please note that this is new learning - complete the activities at your own pace and choose what you would like to work on. Have fun and use your addition and counting skills to help you! Key Vocabulary:

Unit fraction, non-unit fraction, whole, part of, tenth, numerator, denominator, half, third, quarter, fifth, sixth, sequences.

Activities for the week ahead:

Lesson 1- Unit and non-unit fractions

Find out what fractions of shapes have been coloured in.

Lesson 2- Making the whole

Use your knowledge of addition to add fractions together and make the whole. For example, $\frac{1}{3} + \frac{2}{3} = \frac{3}{3}$ or 1 whole.

Lesson 3- Tenths

Colour in the tenths and identify the fractions that have been coloured in!

Lesson 4- Counting in tenths

Identify the missing fractions and complete the sequences. Count in tenths.
