#### Activities for the week ahead:

#### **Lesson 1- Ordering Fractions**

Use your developing knowledge of fractions to place them in order

#### **Lesson 2- Adding Fractions**

Use the bar models, part-whole models and diagrams to help you to add fractions with the same denominator together.

#### **Lesson 3- Subtracting Fractions**

Use the bar models, part-whole models and diagrams to help you to subtract fractions. Remember that when the numerator and the denominator are the same that the fraction is a whole.
