Our theme for the next two weeks is 'The little Red Hen'.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSE)	We will be continuing with thinking about "what makes a good friend" and creating our own golden values for Team Nursery. As a next step we will discuss being kind and helpful unlike the friends in the story 'The Little Red Hen'
Physical Development (PD)	The children will be making bread in nursery and we will be thinking about where our ingredients have come from and how to wash our hands correctly.
Communication & Language (CL)	We will be sharing the story 'The Little Red Hen' over the next two weeks to introduce the children to Harvest. We will set up a small world table for the children to explore the farm and the different animals. The children will have lots of opportunities to listen to the story and have a go at anticipating key events.
Literacy (LD)	The children will be able to mark make in flour! We will use our finger tips to draw circles and lines and maybe their initial sound of their names. The children will be introduced to the H sound such as hen, hat, happy.
Mathematical Development (MD)	The children will have opportunities to compare quantities and begin to use mathematical language such as 'more' cows or 'less' pigs. We will be focusing on number recognition 1-4 also.
Understanding the World (UW)	The children will be learning about Harvest and where does our food come from? We will also explore our outdoor environment for signs of autumn.
Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)	The children will have a go at making their own puppets to support our story of the week. We will also use paint however using a variety of different resources such as wheat or autumn treasures such as conkers.
Nursery Challenge	Please can you go on an autumn treasure hunt over the weekend and collect some signs of autumn or Harvest (wheat) which can be used to support your child's learning. Thankyou ☺
