Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSE)	This week, we will play 'Say Something Nice' when we talk to our friends about why we like to play with them.
Physical Development (PD)	We will make and use playdough this week which will be enhanced with knives and forks. Currently all food served at lunchtime is eaten by hand so using cutlery during our malleable play gives us an extra opportunity to practice its use and to strengthen our hand muscles.
Communication & Language (CL)	Over the next week or two, will learn to retell the story of 'Little Red Hen' using picture prompts and actions and will perform for Nursery next week.
Literacy (LD)	<p>Our focus will be on the sounds <b>ck,e,u,r</b> and the tricky/high frequency words <b>and, the</b> and <b>to</b>.</p> <p>This week the children will come home with a 'Tricky Word Book' to support sight recognition of undecodable words. Please read the insert and follow the instructions. I will also send home a Phase 2 sound mat and a set of flashcards with all the Phase 2 letters. Please support your child by using them regularly in order to secure their grapheme (letter) phoneme (sound) connection.</p>
Mathematical Development (MD)	We will focus on describing the properties of 2D shapes (particularly circle, triangle, square, rectangle and star) and using positional language.
Understanding the World (UW)	During registration, one of us chooses a greeting from another language as we learn to say hello in a variety of ways.
Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)	We will each design our own Supertato which we will bring home to look after.
