THE SPIRIT OF CHRISTMAS ROUTE

we expect to enter:

- Broadmead at 4.20 (inc Burnside E&W Dene)
- Brandreth Drive at 4.40
- Tan House Lane at 5.00 (inc Convent Close, Tanhouse Close) then left on to Lancaster Lane
- Brandreth Delph at 5.20, back to Lancaster Lane
- The Common at 5.35 (inc Lindley Drive & The Heys)
- Lathom Avenue at 5.50 out and past the Library.
- Greenfield Avenue at 5.55 out and to The Common—Mill Lane
- West View at 6.05
- Mill Leat at 6.10
- Beech avenue at 6.15 back on to Mill Lane and A5209
- Brookfield at 6.30
- Bramble Way at 6.35

The van will then continue up the A5209, left in to Lancaster Lane, left again to Tanhouse Lane and (by this point it will be driven at a normal speed) left past the shops to Coffee Etc.

We apologise in advance for the roads we have been unable to include, but some are simply too narrow to be able to turn the van around and therefore we hope those residents will join us on one of the adjoining roads instead.
