Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSE)	The children will be able to dress up in lots of Christmas outfits and act out a role play with their friends to get in the Christmas spirit! We will be enjoying our snow/party day on Thursday with our friends.
Physical Development (PD)	We will be developing our physical skills as we participate in our 1 mile run/walk.
Communication & Language (CL)	The children will be sharing lots of Christmas stories with their friends and they will have the opportunity to retell them in a group, during circle time to develop their dialogical reading.
Literacy (LD)	The children will be independently mark making their own Christmas lists during their play. We will use our imagination to post them in our nursery post box.
Mathematical Development (MD)	The children will be continuing with basic counting skills and we will be watching number blocks to reinforce this.
Understanding the World (UW)	The children will be exploring our artificial snow as we set up our Christmas table supported with mark making resources, stories and more!
