Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSE)	Picture News asks us to think about why we listen to music and how it can affect our mood. We will listen to a variety of genres of music throughout the week to see if it changes our mood and attach words to match our mood.
Communication & Language (CL)	Our dinosaur theme is giving us ample opportunity to broaden our vocabulary, some of which I hope the children are sharing with you at home.
Physical Development (PD)	Finger gym continues to be a highlight of the day and these regular sessions have had a super impact on Team Crane's fine motor skills. Mathematical Development (MD)	We will continue to concentrate on measure, with weight being our main focus. We will encourage language such as weigh, weights, balance, heavy, light, heavier, lighter, heaviest, lightest, scales.....
Understanding of the World (UW)	We will receive a letter from a palaeontologist who will inform us of the possibility of dinosaur bones on our school field!
Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)	We will use salt dough to make our own fossils.
