




# Nursery Home Liaison

## 24<sup>th</sup> May 2021



We are continuing with our theme of 'People who help us' and this will be supported through our story of 'Tiddler'. We wish you all an enjoyable two weeks off and we will see you back on the 14<sup>th</sup> June.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSE)	To continue with our theme of 'people who help us' our role play area will be developed into other job roles such as a vets, police station, a classroom and the children will be supported to develop these occupations and relationships with their friends.
Physical Development (PD)	The children will participate in hall activities which will allow them to recognise and observe the effects of exercise on their bodies. We will think about how to keep our bodies healthy and remind ourselves of where to go if we are feeling unwell.
Communication & Language (CL)	During circle time the children will discuss our community in Newburgh and think about some special job roles and people who help us. The children will also extend their knowledge on different vocabulary such as a stethoscope for the doctors or an altar for the Church etc.
Literacy (LD)	Linking to our story of 'Tiddler' who is a story telling fish, the children will be encouraged to make up and share their own stories and we will record these via video or on paper.

Understanding the World (UW)	This week the children will participate in <b>job show and tell</b> where they will share their future job role to their friends during circle time and develop their knowledge of that occupation and why they want to do that specific job when they grow up.
Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)	Finally, in the workshop area the children will be able to create puppets of themselves (mini ME's) in their specific outfit of their chosen job to reinforce the different occupations we have learnt about.
Nursery Home Challenge	Over the May half term we would like you to continue to share stories with your child to support a LOVE of reading. To continue with Tiddler and story-telling, if your child would like to share their own made up story or a story they know well, you can upload it to tapestry so we can share these with everyone when we return.
