	own wanted posters for the Gruffalo. We will also continue with story-telling and allowing the
	children to retell key phrases within the story.
Mathematical	This week in small groups the children will be making 'Gruffalo crumble'. They will use their
Development (MD)	mathematical skills to measure, count and add together quantities in order to make their crumble.
Understanding the	During forest school the children will be able to create their own Gruffalo faces using a range of
World (UW)	natural materials in the outdoor area. They will each use the camera to take a picture of their
	master piece. We will also discuss and think about different habitats the animals in the story may
	live in and where we would find them during forest school.
Expressive Arts &	Finally, the children will be supported to create their own Gruffalo masks in the workshop area to
Design (EAD)	support their role play. The role play area will become 'The Gruffalo's Cave'.
Nursery Home	Your home challenge is to cook or bake something together at home, this could be your own
