Language (CL)	and find it'. The children will also have opportunities to go on listening walks and colour walks. We
	will encourage the children to listen to the sounds in our environment and predict what we might
	hear in the jungle. We will also spot a variety of colours in our outdoor environment and record
	the colours we find!
Literacy (LD)	The children will be focusing on the 'e' sound for example: elephant, Elmer, Ellie, eggs. We will be
	using lots of resources in nursery so that the children become confident on this sound. The
	children will have a go at drawing their own portraits and discuss what makes them unique, like
	Elmer.
Mathematical	The children will be focusing on a 'square' and exploring the properties such as how many sides?
Development (MD)	How many corners? The children will be able to recreate their own Elmer using 2D shapes.
Understanding the	The children will participate in a science experiment in which we will discover what happens to the
World (UW)	colours from the skittles when added to water.
Expressive Arts &	The children will work together to collage a large Elmer to display in nursery and the children will
Design (EAD)	be introduced to basic patterns. They will also have opportunities to mix colours and explore what
	the outcomes will be.
Nursery Challenge	We would like you to focus on routines whilst at home. This can be focusing on getting ready in a
	morning, bath time, story time, bed time etc. We have attached a useful link about the importance
