Enrichment Opportunities at Newburgh

During the past 18 months children have missed out on many opportunities. We have put together an ambitious and full enrichment timetable to provide lots of engaging extra-curricular opportunities for children.

Children from Years 1-6 will be invited to the clubs that we have arranged for the first half of the Autumn Term (Reception children start to be invited to clubs in the summer term once they are fully settled into school). The clubs on offer will be rotated around year groups across the school year. We are unable to offer unlimited places in our clubs so they will be on a first come first serve basis. Where numbers are limited our maximum number is shown in brackets after the club.

Our lunchtime clubs are being run by staff and do not need permission to attend. The clubs that happen outside of normal school hours will require permission via Parent Pay for children to attend. Our Breakfast Choir Club also requires a payment of £2 per session. Children will be dismissed from afterschool clubs via the black door on the playground. Children attending choir club should also arrive via this door.

Please talk to your child(ren) about the clubs that are on offer to help them consider which activities they wish to participate in this half term. There will be more opportunities for them every half term! The clubs will appear on Parent Pay tomorrow for you to book children a place. If the club does not appear on Parent Pay, it is already fully subscribed; please then email Chrissy so we can put children onto the waiting list for next half term. Please note sign up to Breakfast Choir Club is for the full term, all other clubs are just until October half term.

We hope that children find our offer engaging and stimulating and I am extremely grateful to the staff of Newburgh for giving up their time to provide these opportunities for children.



I must also thank our PTA once again as their support allows us to run these clubs with a wealth of resources for free for this term to give children as many opportunities as possible.
