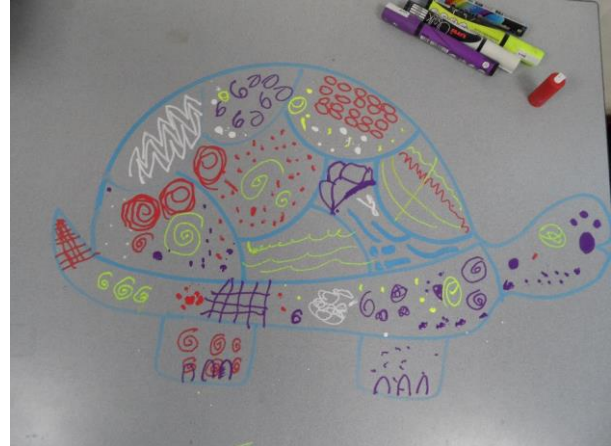

PTA: Finally please see the final page of the Newsletter to welcome you all into our incredible Parent Teacher Association.

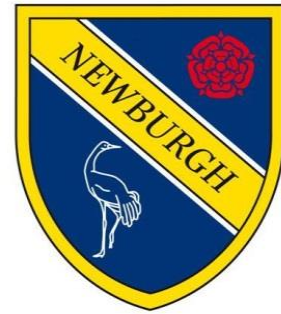

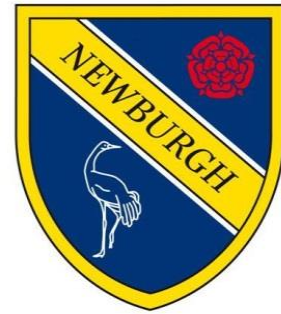
We are a friendly bunch and we'd love to meet you at our AGM on Wednesday 6th October at 6.30pm. There will be wine and cheese, need I say more??
