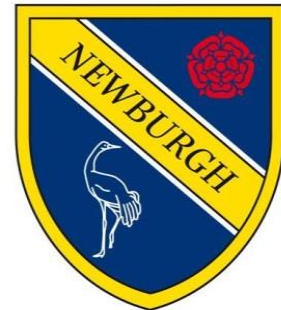

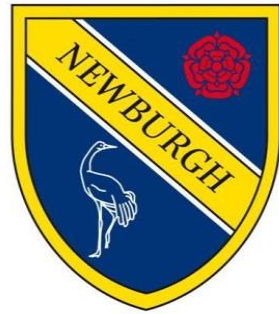

Team Crane have made apple shrunken heads and paper aeroplanes to measure how far they can fly.



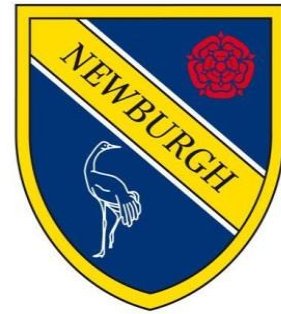
Team Halton finished their work on Kadinsky and moved on to Jackson Pollock
