Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSE) & Communication & Language (CL)	We learn about the origins of Remembrance Day and acknowledge its significance today as we think about friends and family we miss, supporting the children's emotional well-being throughout.
Physical Development (PD)	As part of our fish research, we will look closely at a fish bought from a fish monger and identify parts of its body and compare its ability to swim with our own. We will try a variety of fish for our snack on Thursday.
Literacy (LD)	We will focus on sounds ch (chin), sh (shop) and th (thin) which we describe as '2 letters, 1 sound' and also letter names. We will also start 'Buddy Reading' sessions during which we will spend time sharing a book with our buddies.
Mathematical Development (MD)	We will use the Numberblock character 'Blockzilla' to further our knowledge of 'greater than'. Blockzilla is a monster who has less than/greater than/equals signs for a mouth. Understanding the World (UW)	We will walk to the war memorial to lay a poppy wreath (which we will make) and learn about the significance of historical sources in the community.
