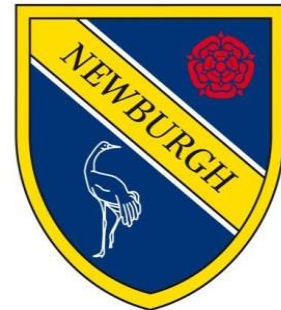

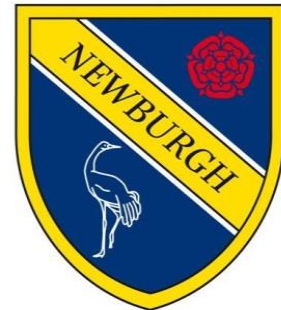

 - b. Go into Menu → Settings → Amazon Smile → Turn On Amazon Smile. (If your App doesn't show Amazon Smile in settings, leave it for a few hours and repeat step 4.)
