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| Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSE) | We continue to rehearse our Christmas performance, helping each other if we begin to feel nervous or over excited. |
| Communication & Language (CL) | We will share our memories of previous Christmases. Please share your memories of childhood Christmases with your son or daughter and talk about any special family customs you have. |
| Physical Development (PD) | As our role play area evolves into a Nativity scene, the children will have opportunity to use the dressing up resources to get themselves dressed into character. |
| Literacy (LD) | Children will choose their own reading book this week to supplement the one from our reading scheme. This book may not always be entirely phonetically decodable, however it gives the children opportunities to apply other reading strategies such as picture cues, prediction and comprehension. Our focus digraphs (2 letters, one sound) are 'igh' as in high, 'oa' as in goat and 'oo' as in boot and look and the tricky word 'was'. |
| Mathematical Development (MD) | 2D shape, pattern and sequence will be our maths focus this week. If you see any sequence patterns at home or when you are out and about, point them out and talk about them.
