

Dear Parents, Carers & Children

Welcome Back: I hope you had an enjoyable Easter break. We've had a really positive start to the summer term with our School Families spending the afternoon together working on our new Gospel Value – Trust. It's always nice to see children across year groups interacting together and the children carried out lots of thought provoking activities such as trusting each other to be lead around obstacle courses blindfolded and thinking about who they trust.

Enrichment Clubs: We have slightly reduced our Enrichment Clubs offer for the summer term. 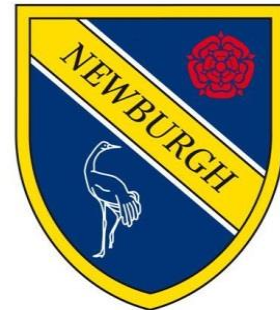
