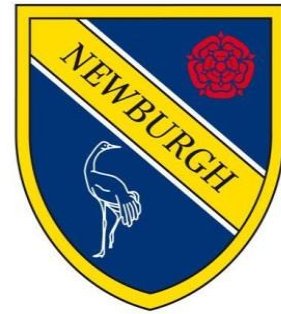

Volunteers Needed: We still need volunteers to help our Year 5 and 6 children make bunting to decorate school for the Jubilee. Can you help?

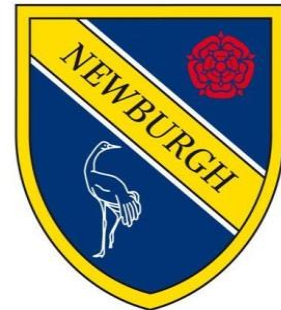
On Thursday 26th May our Year 1 and 2 children will be going on a canal walk. If any parents of these year groups are available to join us as volunteers you would be very welcome.

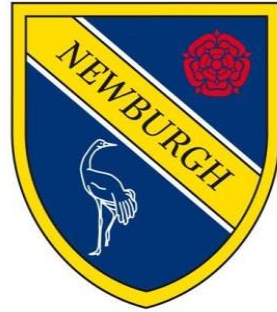
