


Nursery Home Liaison

16th and 23rd May 2022



Our theme for the next two weeks is: 'People who help us' and this will be supported through our story of 'The Smartest Giant in Town'.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSE)	The children will be sharing our story which represents the 'kindness giant', and during collective worship we will share 'The Good Samaritan' and consider what we need to do to be kind to each other.
Physical Development (PD)	We will be having a focus on being independent and this will be encouraged through our role play area as we will set up a doctors surgery/hospital for the children to look after and care for our teddies by applying bandages, feeding them and supporting their needs etc. The children will be encouraged to become more independent by putting on their own shoes and taking off their jumpers etc.
Communication & Language (CL)	When sharing our story of the week the children will be encouraged to think of alternative storylines such as different ways we can help the animals in the story and how being helpful is a good quality to have.
Literacy (LD)	The children will participate in ' Book Show and Tell ' in which your child can bring in their favourite book to share with their friends. This will support our children to develop a love for reading. Your child can bring their book in which ever day suits you and show and tell will be organised within nursery.
Mathematical Development (MD)	The children will be exploring the outdoor environment during forest school and going on a size hunt. We will be looking for the largest objects we can find and the smallest etc. We will look at ordering them in size order and developing our mathematical language and vocabulary.
Understanding the World (UW)	This week we would like to invite our parents to either share a short video of themselves on tapestry about their job roles to develop the children's knowledge of different occupations or you are welcome to come in and bring in props to share a short session with the children. Please speak to a member of staff if this is something you are interested in and we can arrange a suitable time. The children will be able to use the internet to search for a range of job roles that they are interested in to extend their knowledge.
Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)	Finally, as our role play has developed into a doctor's surgery/hospital, the children will be encouraged to use props to extend their experiences with their friends and reinforce the new occupations they have learnt about. Within the construction area both indoors and out, the children can recreate bridges for 'crossing the bog' which can be continued within their small world play.
Nursery Home Challenge	To support our focus on 'people who help us', can you please share with your child your home address so that they are aware of it and be able to recall it, and develop their knowledge of who to call in an emergency (999). This will lead on to our 'mini first aiders' session when we return after half term.
