A lovely welcome back, we are continuing with our theme of 'People who help us' and this will be supported through our story of 'Tiddler'.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSE)	To continue with our theme of 'people who help us' our role play area will be developed into other job roles such as a vet, police station, a classroom, and the children will be supported to develop these occupations and relationships with their friends.
Physical Development (PD)	The children will participate in hall activities which will allow them to recognise and observe the effects of exercise on their bodies. We will think about how to keep our bodies healthy and remind ourselves of where to go or what to do if we are feeling unwell.
Communication & Language (CL)	During circle time the children will discuss our community in Newburgh and think about some special job roles and people who help us. The children will develop their knowledge of different vocabulary such as a stethoscope for the doctors or an altar for the Church. The children will be taking a trip to our local post office over the next two weeks.
Literacy (LD)	Linking to our story of 'Tiddler' who is a story telling fish, the children will be encouraged to make up and share their own stories and we will record these. We will be writing our names and designing our special Father's Day cards.
Mathematical Development (MD)	The children will have the opportunity to access a counting activity on top marks which can also be accessed at home to support the development of your child's mathematical skills. You can access many maths activities on top marks which can be adapted to your child's ability. https://www.topmarks.co.uk/learning-to-count/underwater-counting
Understanding the World (UW)	This week the children will participate in job show and tell . They will share their dream job role to their friends during circle time and develop their knowledge of that occupation and why they want to do that specific job when they grow up. Your child can bring in supporting resources to enable them to participate in this.
Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)	Finally, in the workshop area the children will be able to create puppets of themselves (mini ME's) in their specific outfit of their chosen job, to reinforce the different occupations we have learnt about.
Nursery Home Challenge	To continue with Tiddler and story-telling, if your child would like to share their own made up story or a story they know well, you can upload it to tapestry so we can share these with their friends. You can also do this with 'job show and tell' and record them performing their chosen job role.
