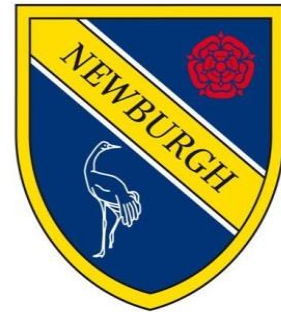

Flu Vaccination Reminder:

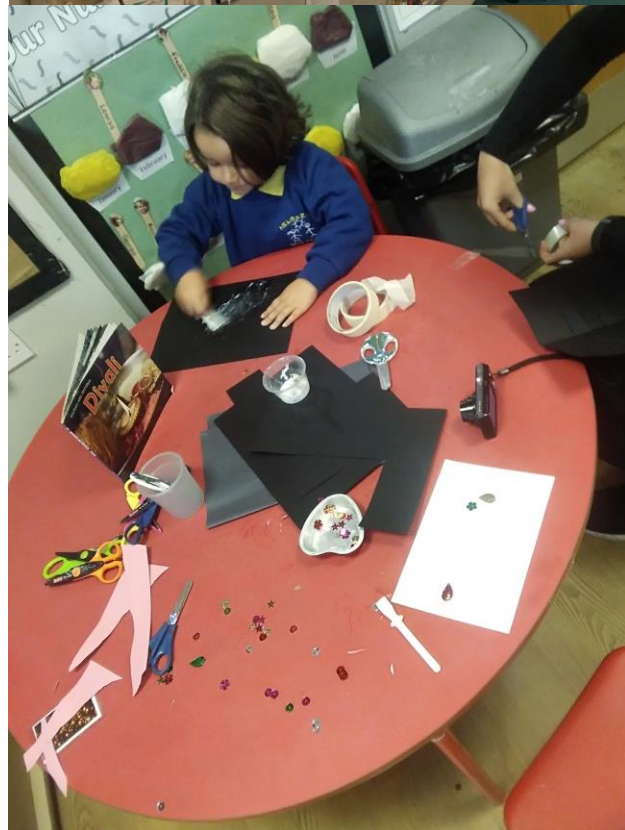
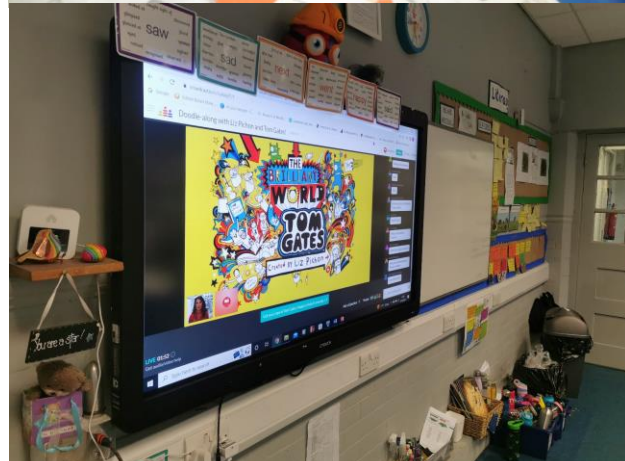
The flu vaccination for all children from Reception to Year 6 has been booked for Tuesday 1st November. Please register children for this using the following link **before 17th October.**

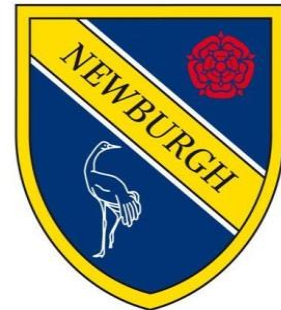

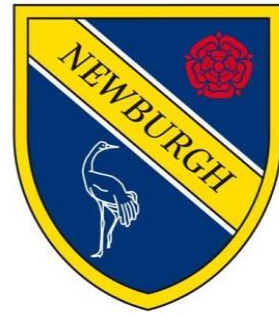

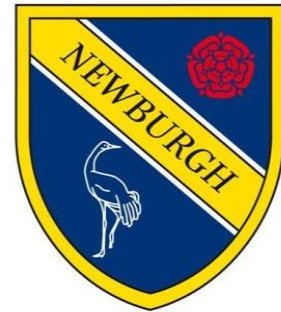
Moment of Mindfulness
