Our story for the next two weeks is: After the storm.



Personal, Social, Emotional Development (PSE)	The children will have lots of opportunities to role play the story and use their imagination to build the final tree house for all the animals within the story. We will also consider how kind and helpful Percy is and continue with how we can be kind friends in nursery.
Physical Development (PD)	The children will use the playdough to make woodland animals and use loose parts to support this for example match sticks for the hedgehog spikes and acorns for eyes. We will also make jam sandwiches and have our own picnic during forest school. To continue with our scissors skills we will make our own poppies for Remembrance Day.
Communication & Language (CL)	The children will be supported to use the sequence cards to order the story during the small world play. We will complete a sinking and floating experiment to consider what would be a good boat like the wheelbarrow used in the story. The children will be introduced to Remembrance Day during circle time.
Literacy (LD)	The children will have lots of opportunities to mark make a variety of woodland animals. We will also be focusing on initial sounds for example the 'S' sound for storm.
Mathematical Development (MD)	The children will look at basic 2D shapes and which shapes are best for building houses and why. We will also go on a number hunt within our indoor and outdoor environment.
Understanding the World (UW)	In nursery there will be an investigation table filled with autumn treasures and we will look at a variety of different types of weather and record the weather throughout the week on our weather display. The children will be able to watch an age appropriate clip to support our Remembrance Day activities. You can watch it here https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/watch/poppies
Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)	The children will be encouraged to collage an autumn treasure picture and take a picture of their artwork using the IPad. The children can independently construct their own animal homes using a variety of resources such as wooden blocks and cardboard boxes in the workshop area.
Nursery Challenge	As the weather is turning colder please can you support your child to be independent such as putting on their own coat. Also, having a go at doing their own shoes especially practising for forest school, thank you.
