Literacy (LD)	The children will be able to mark make different characters of the Nativity and create their own
	scene. We will also be mark making our names in our Christmas cards for our families.
Mathematical	The children will be identifying how many objects are in a set depending on their ability and we
Development (MD)	will be recognising that the last number is the total of all the objects.
Understanding the World (UW)	The children will be looking at different countries on the internet of how people may celebrate
	Christmas and how they may do it differently to us. The Children will be able to use the
	interactive board to draw their own Christmas celebrations.
Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)	Finally, we will be learning our Christmas songs ready for our performance! The children will be
	supported to make their very own Christmas decorations and 2023 calendars in the workshop
	which they will take home.
